

## Privacy Policy

This privacy policy applies between you (the user of this website and The Stonecold Studios (the owner and provider of this website)). The Stonecold Studios takes the privacy of your information very seriously. This privacy policy applies to our use of any and all data collected by us or provided by you in relation to your use of the website. Please read this privacy policy carefully. This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of your information when you use our website.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Service. By using this website and our Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- "We", "Us" or "Our" in this agreement refers to The Stonecold Studios.
- Cookies are small files that are placed on your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of your browsing history on that website among its many uses. Cookies are sent to your browser from a web site and stored on your computer's hard drive. Like many sites, we use "cookies" to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Site. Device means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a mobile phone or a digital tablet.
- Personal Data is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual. Data means collectively all information that you submit to The Stonecold Studios via the website.
- Service refers to the Website.
- Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of The Stonecold Studios. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by us to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of us, to perform services related to the Service or to assist us in analysing how the Service is used.
- Third-party Social Media Service refers to any website or any social network website through which a User can log in or create an account to use the Service.
- Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).
- Website refers to The Stonecold Studios, accessible from <https://www.stonecoldstudios.co.uk/>
- You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Introduction,

- Information Collection And Use

While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally, identifiable information may include but is not limited to your name ("Personal Information").

- Data we process

We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you. We have collated these into groups as follows:

Your identity includes information such as first name, last name, title, date of birth, and other identifiers that you may have provided at some time.

Your contact information includes information such as billing address, delivery address, email address, telephone numbers and any other information you have given to us for the purpose of communication or meeting.

Your financial data includes information such as your bank account and payment card details.

Transaction data includes details about payments or communications to and from you and information about products and services you have purchased from us.

- Special personal information

Special personal information is data about your race or ethnicity, religious or philosophical beliefs, sex life, sexual orientation, political opinions, trade union membership, information about your health and genetic and

biometric data. It also includes information about criminal convictions and offences. We do not collect any special personal information about you.

- If you do not provide personal information we need

Where we need to collect personal data by law, or under the terms of a contract we have with you, and you fail to provide that data when requested, we may not be able to perform that contract. In that case, we may have to stop providing a service to you.

- Information we process with your consent

Through certain actions when otherwise there is no contractual relationship between us, such as when you browse our website or ask us to provide you more information about our business, our products and services, you provide your consent to us to process information that may be personal information.

With this consent, we may from time to time pass your name and contact information to selected associates whom we consider may provide services or products you would find useful. We continue to process your information on this basis until you withdraw your consent or it can be reasonably assumed that your consent no longer exists. You may withdraw your consent at any time by instructing us by email. However, if you do so, you may not be able to use our website or our services further.

- Information relating to your method of payment

We do not store information about your debit or credit card or other means of payment when you first provide it to us.

We do not keep all your payment information so as:

- a) to prevent the possibility of our duplicating a transaction without a new instruction from you;
- b) to prevent any other third party from carrying out a transaction without your consent

We need to provide this payment information in order to make repeat purchasing of goods and services next time you visit our website.

- Communicating with us

When you contact us, whether by telephone, through our website or by e-mail, we collect the data you have given to us in order to reply with the information you need.

We may use your Personal Information to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information.

- Information we obtain from third parties

Although we do not disclose your personal information to any third party (except as set out in this notice), we sometimes receive data that is indirectly made up from your personal information from third parties whose services we use.

No such information is personally identifiable to you.

- Third party advertising on our website

Third parties may advertise on our website. In doing so, those parties, their agents or other companies working for them may use technology that automatically collects information about you when their advertisement is displayed on our website.

They may also use other technology such as cookies or JavaScript to personalise the content of and to measure the performance of their adverts. We do not have control over these technologies or the data that these parties obtain. Accordingly, this privacy notice does not cover the information practices of these third parties.
